







The Black Forest in southwestern Germany is known for its dense forests, charming villages, and scenic beauty. Our lunch stop brings us to the popular spa town of Baden-Baden where the Roman-Irish baths, 19th-century performance hall and elegant architecture are popular cultural attractions. From the famous fairytale villages, thermal baths, and pine- and birch-blanketed mountains to scenic drives and a rich mix of natural beauty, culture, and charm — this region truly showcases the best of the area. The B500, the Black Forest High Road is a truly unique driving experience. Sitting at the foot of the Black Forest's wooded slopes and vineyards, we find our base for the second night in the Colombi Hotel in Freiburg im Breisgau. A historic and elegant hotel known for its exceptional service and luxurious amenities. Freiburg is a sunny, cheerful town with gabled townhouses, cobblestone lanes and cafe-rimmed plazas.
















From Andermatt we head to our overnight in Luxembourg, we recommend stopping for lunch in the picturesque medieval old town of Colmar located in the Alsace region of France, known as 'Little Venice' We drive The Grimsel Pass which is one of the highest paved roads in Europe and runs through a wild, sparsely grown mountainous region marked by granite rocks, reservoir lakes, and power plants. LE ROYAL HOTEL LUXEMBOURG 5*







HOTEL OKURA AMSTERDAM 5*








